"TRAEVITI-Coll. TO ACCOMPANY VITICULTURE TO AGRO-ECOLOGY Transfer of VITIcoles Agro-Environmental measures to Collectives.

The "TRAEVITI-Coll. project proposes to accompany the agroecological transition of voluntary wine collectives. The goal of TRAEVITI-Coll. is to help thought, and realisation of the implementation of agri-environmental measures at individual or collective scales, and to help national and international recognition of commitments and initiatives. The project relies on groups of motivated winegrowers eagger to go towards the agroecological transition, such as the declared ODG engaged in the implementation of agri-environmental measures in their specifications. Knowledge, initiatives, networks, professions, bodies are mobilized in ascending and descending currents.

The project is articulated in 4 actions:

- 1. Mobilization and commitment of professional wine-growing authorities and production areas for agri-environmental measures
- 2. National survey and call for expressions of interest to the project
- 3. Accompaniment of the collectives for the agroecological transition
- 4. Valorisation of agroecological transition initiatives on an interactive sound card

The expected advances are as follows:

- Triggering and accelerating agroecological and landscape dynamics
- Deployment of agroecological viticultural transition approaches in the territory and the collectives
- Integration of agri-environmental measures into the specifications of the ODGs, AOCs IGPs and landscape and environmental networks

- National and international recognition of the development of agroecological transition approaches adapted to societal and responsible expectations, at the concerted and integrated scales of the ODGs, groups including GIEE, landscape networks, vine growers, including those affiliated to the Déphy network.
